

FLIVVER RALLY

1. Vehicles will be limited to a fair market value of no more than \$500. A true flivver can't be worth more than that.
2. Teams will consist of at least four members. There is no limit on non-driving crew members. Drag friends and co-workers along, you'll need them.
3. Each member of the team must drive and co-drive at least one leg. The rally will be divided into four legs which may not be totally equal. Prepare to argue.
4. At the end of the rally, the organizers may elect to purchase the vehicles engine from its owner(s) for \$200. A junkyard motor can make lots more power than the cheater one we buy and turn into a coffee table.
5. Vehicles must be naturally aspirated and have no more than 4 cylinders.
6. Vehicles must only be 2WD. Cheap doesn't come in all wheel drive.
7. Vehicles must be mass-produced, four-wheeled cars or trucks legal for US highway use at the time of their manufacture.
8. Suspension is free as long as the stock mounting location and type is maintained. It's been said that a free suspension is a great suspension!
9. Vehicles and competitor safety gear must meet the requirements of the organization sanctioning the rally.
10. Competitors must meet all the licensing requirements of the organization sanctioning the rally. Having a rally driver's license has its privileges.
